Family Studies Electives: **CFS 4356** *The Family: A Global Perspective* †, **SWO4322** or **CFS 4357** *Child & Family Policy and Advocacy* † (spring only), **4364** *Child and Family Ministry* (spring only) & **4367** *Family Transitions, Stress, and Resilience* † (spring only) **(12 hours)** Note: these classes taught only one semester a year.

† CFLE: courses required for certification as Family Life Educator. Must also take: CFS 3354, 4191, 4356, 4357, 4365, 4367, CSS 4313 (or CSS 3311) and PUBH 4321. (Adds 4 hrs to total credits.)

CFS Upper Level Electives: any 3000-4000 level CFS course **(6 hours)** Take CFS 4365 *Adult Development* (fall only) for CFLE.
