ID 1332 Introduction to Interior Design **or**  
ID 3313 Histories of Interiors I **or**  
ID 4313 History of Interiors II
- iv. NUTR 1401 Introduction to Food Science **or**  
NUTR 2351 Nutrition **or**  
NUTR 3314 Consumer Nutrition

C. Choose 9 semester hours of upper level courses in the Family and Consumer Sciences department (ADM, CFS, FCS, ID, or NUTR). All prerequisites must be taken for upper-level courses.

D. A grade of “C” is required for all courses in the minor.
