First Year Review: Successful completion of the First-Year review is required for advancement to the Second Year studios. At the end of the first year review the following is required: 1. A minimum GPA of 2.85 or higher in the ID and Art courses required in the freshman level sequencing.**Second Year Review:** This review is a selective process by which the design faculty identifies students who are prepared in skills and knowledge to proceed to the junior level studio courses. Requirements for Second Year Review: 1. Overall GPA of 2.5 at the end of the fall term prior to the Second Year review to make application. 2. A 2.85 overall in Interior Design Courses at the end of the Spring Semester.

Post-matriculation students wishing to change their major to ID must have a minimum GPA of 2.25 in order to be accepted into the ID program. First semester freshmen without a Baylor GPA must wait until the end of their first term when grades post (showing a 2.25 gpa) in order to formally change into the ID program.

Due to course sequencing, a minimum of three years is required to complete major requirements for interior design.
